JUNIOR HIGH AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS: All junior high and high school students are to come in **complete uniform** for the first day, including bringing a hijab for prayer time. Any new students who have uniforms on backorder should come in an abaya or long black skirt and long sleeve shirt. Students are to bring a backpack, pen or pencil and notebook paper for the first day. Student schedules and locker assignments will be distributed on this day. Students may bring items to prepare their lockers for the school year. As a reminder, summer reading assignments are on the website on the registration tab and must be completed before the first day of school. Lunch will be provided for all JH/HS Students (cheese pizza and salad- if you have a dietary restriction please bring a lunch from home). All junior high and high school students will be dismissed from the West Door.

ELEMENTARY STUDENTS: Elementary students may be **out of uniform** for the first day of school. Parents are encouraged to bring their child's school supplies on the first day (please remember to label all of your child's supplies). No lunch will be served because it is a half day, but students in grades Pre-K-5th should bring a snack. Please be sure to complete all registration forms and indicate any allergies your child may have so that any treats distributed align with safety and diet restrictions.
